

Using an analog modem

If you are using an analog modem, it will take a certain time for the audio files to be downloaded. The MP3-Player-Plugin works with *streaming method* i.e. it plays as it downloads. This causes interruptions in playing the audio files using a slow *56k modem*. Please press the PLAY-button again as soon as the audio file has been downloaded completely. You can always stop the download by deactivating the PLAY-function (right mouse click on audio player).

Requested Plugins for Firefox and Opera

Additionally to *Shockwave* you may have to install the **Adobe Flash Player Plugin** (Version 9.0.45.0) for Firefox and Opera.

Special information for Opera browser

If you should have further problems playing the audio files in the Opera browser, please try the following:

- Download *Opera Browser 9.10* from the Internet and install it (please remove all other versions of the Opera browser before).
- Download **Shockwave_Installer_Full.exe** (9.0.0.434) from the Internet. Then please rename this file into "Shockwave_Installer_Full.zip" and unpack this file into a folder. If you cannot see the file extension, change settings in the folder options of your operation system, in Windows for example under:

*Extras\Folder Options\View\Hidden files and folders/
Hide extensions for known file types*

- Copy file **NP32DSW.DLL** from this folder into your local folder

C:\programme\Opera\program\plugins

- Open the Opera Browser again. Playing the audio files should now not be a problem any more.
